

OUT OF STATE CERTIFIED OFFICER POSITION MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be law enforcement certified, current and in good standing
- Minimum two years' experience from certification date
- No more than a 2 year break in service in not currently employed
- Must take and pass the Connecticut Police Chiefs Association (CPCA) Police
 Officer Entry Exam
- No felony convictions
- No Class A or Class B misdemeanor convictions
- No Domestic Violence convictions
- No act of perjury or false statement
- Not dismissed from any former law enforcement unit for malfeasance or other serious misconduct (or resigned or retired while under investigation for same)
- Upon hiring Residence within 40 miles of police headquarters
- Pass an employment psychological and polygraph examination
- Pass a comprehensive medical exam and drug screen
- Vision -Corrected 20/30 Uncorrected 20/100
- No tattoos on or above the neck, or on hands (*exceptions apply)

Minority and female participation is encouraged.
