QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a U.S. citizen or possess a valid and authorized Immigration & Naturalization citizenship in the US
- Must be 18 years of age by Application Deadline - Sept. 15, 2023
- High School Diploma or General Equivalency Degree
- Must Possess and maintain a valid motor vehicle operators license

SELECTION PROCESS

- Candidates who meet the qualifications will be evaluated in the following phases:
- **Fit2Serve** –Physical Agility test, Written exam: June — Sept. 2023
- Oral interview, Background investigation, Medical exam / Drug test
- Psychological exam to demonstrate fitness for duty
- Must pass a basic swim test prior to appointment to the Police Training Academy
- Graduate the Municipal Police Training Academy
