All applicants must be 18 years of age and possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent. Applications must be submitted via www.policeapp.com/CranstonRI by 11:59pm, Sunday, October 1, 2023.

All applicants must also register with Fit2Serve for the Physical Agility Test and the Written Exam via fit2serveri.com/testing.

EXAMINATION PROCESS:

PHYSICAL AGILITY TEST

The Physical Agility Test will be administered by **Fit2Serve** along with members of the Cranston Police Department present on the following dates:

June 10, 2023 West Warwick Civic Center

July 22, 2023 Cranston West High School Track August 26, 2023 Cranston West High School Track

September 23, 2023 West Warwick Civic Center

Candidates must provide a passing certified physical assessment certificate from one of the test dates listed above or from a prior physical assessment from Fit2Serve dated no later than October 1, 2022. Failure to pass the agility test shall prevent an

applicant from advancing in the examination process. Please refer to the below agility test Standards which also can be found at www.RIMPA.gov.

You must bring the completed <u>Fitness Test Medical Certificate</u> and <u>Waiver and Assumption</u> of <u>Risk Assessment Form</u> for the physical agility test. You will not be allowed to take the agility test without these forms completed. Applicants must provide photo identification. There is a fee of \$100 for this Physical Agility Test. In addition, the physical agility exam will include a swim test consisting of swimming continuously for 200 yards and tread water for 10 minutes at a later date in October 2023.

If offered conditional employment, the applicant will be required to pass the Rhode Island Municipal Police Training Academy swimming standards prior to entering the academy. The standards include swimming continuously for 200 yards; tread water for 10 minutes; swimming the distance of 30 feet underwater; surface dive to 12 ft, retrieve a weight, and bring it to the surface. Any inability to swim or to successfully complete these swimming requirements will prevent an appointment to the position of police officer.

WRITTEN EXAM

The Written Exam will be administered online by **Fit2Serve** on the following dates:

June 9,10,11, 2023 July 21,22,23, 2023 August 25,26,27 2023 September 22,23,24 2023

Applicants can take the written exam at any location using a computer with internet access and a camera attached. Candidates must provide a passing certified Written Exam certificate from one of the test dates listed above or from a written assessment

from Fit2Serve, dated no later than October 1, 2021. Failure to pass the Written Exam with a 70 or above shall prevent an applicant from advancing in the selection process. There is a fee of \$75 for this Written Exam. Applicants must provide photo identification. ORALINTERVIEW

Applicants who have passed the Physical Agility Test and the Written Exam will be allowed to participate in the oral interview during the month of October 2023 (dates to be selected). Applicants must provide photo identification. A passing score will be a 70 or above.

BACKGROUNDINVESTIGATION

Applicants who pass the physical agility and the written exam will receive a background package via email. Applicants will be required to submit all required forms and documents. Incomplete background packets may be rejected. Every applicant must have an acceptable background as determined during the investigation to continue in the recruitment process. ELIGIBILTY LIST

The candidates who successfully complete the above-mentioned process will be placed on the civil service eligibility list, according to their final score of the oral interview to fill future vacancies. An updated background investigation will also be conducted prior to a conditional offer of employment.

The comprehensive background investigation will consist of an integrity interview, extensive investigation of the candidate's history to include, but not be limited to, education, training, health, employment history, family, neighbors, references, character, credit, military, traits and any other areas as directed by the Chief of Police. The applicant must have an acceptable background as determined during the investigation to maintain their eligibility.

MEDICAL & PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTS / DRUG SCREENING

Under Rhode Island State Law, all police candidates must pass a physical exam, including a color blindness test, and a psychological examination prior to being hired for a vacancy. Candidates must successfully pass a medical exam, psychological test and drug screening. In addition, candidates who have not

already done so must then attend and pass all phases of the Rhode Island Municipal Police Training Academy. Upon completion of the Rhode Island Municipal Police Training Academy the officer will be a probationary officer for one full year before permanent appointment.

PREFERENCE

Honorably discharged active duty war veterans who have received a passing final grade of 70% shall have five (5) points added to their final grade and disabled active duty war veterans shall have ten (10) points added to their final grade.

In order to receive credit for veteran's preference, an honorably discharged active duty war veteran must furnish a copy of his/her *DD 214*. A disabled active duty war veteran must submit proof that he/she has been classified as "disabled" by the Veterans Administration. The DD 214 and proof of disability classification must be submitted at the time of the written examination.

If you have been honorably discharged from active duty in Iraq, please submit a copy of the DD214. The City will determine if your status allows you Veterans points for this service.
