



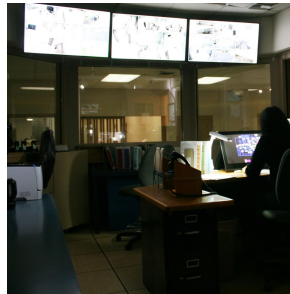

This position utilizes hand-eye coordination to manage and monitor all doors, gates, video surveillance, and intercom systems in the Kootenai County Jail. Communication between this position and Deputies on the floor, as well as inmates via intercom system is a major component of daily activities. If you enjoy working with technology and a fast-paced multi-tasking environment this could be the position for you.
