

CROSSING GUARD

DEFINITION

Under the direction of a Police Department Traffic Safety Unit Sergeant or Lieutenant, on a part time basis, engages in regulating and directing the safe movement of school children at street intersections; performs related work as may be required.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- * Assists children in crossing streets at assigned times and locations in the Borough
 - * Identifies suspicious or dangerous persons around the school
 - * Notifies police when conditions warrant
- Performs other related duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

Ability to read, write, speak, understand or communicate in English sufficiently to perform the duties of the position. Communication may include such forms as American Sign Language or Braille.

Ability to work effectively and harmoniously with the Borough Administrator, other municipal officials, employees and the public

Knowledge of the safety precautions to be taken in the movement and direction of children at intersections

Knowledge of the types of conditions requiring police intervention

Ability to work flexible hours (mornings and afternoon hours)

Ability to interact with parents and children

Persons with mental or physical disabilities are eligible as long as they can perform the essential functions of the job after reasonable accommodation is made to their known limitations. If the accommodation cannot be made because it would cause the employer undue hardship, such persons may not be eligible.

* Essential job function
