Physical Fitness Exam is scheduled for **Saturday March 28, 2026 at 800 a.m.** The physical fitness exam will consist of passing the 4 components listed below following the Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Commission Police Academy Entrance Standards.

- 1 Minute Sit-up
- 300 Meter Run
- 1 Minute Push-Up
- 1.5 Mile Run

Any applicant passing the Physical Fitness Exam will be invited to attend the Written Exam, scheduled for **Saturday, March 28, 2026 immediately following the conclusion of the Physical Fitness Test**.

The successful candidate must:

- be at least 21 years of age prior to completing the academy
- possess a valid driver's license
- must reside within 50 miles of Washington Township Police Department
- possess a diploma from an accredited high school or a GED
- pass physical fitness exam, pass written test & pass oral board interview
- pass physical exam & drug screen, psychological exam, vision exam; visit [MPOETC](#) for all requirements
- pass thorough background investigation & credit check
- if NOT currently Act 120 Certified, must be able to attend and successfully complete the educational requirements to become Act 120 certified by attending the Police Academy (starts July 2026)

The undersigned hereby gives informed consent to engage in a series of procedures relative to taking a battery of exercise tests and participating in a variety of physical activities. The purpose of the testing is to determine physical fitness, cardiovascular function, and health status. All exercise testing and physical activity sessions will be monitored. These activities include walking, running, and calisthenic exercises performed in either field or gymnasium settings.

There exists the possibility that certain detrimental physiological changes may occur during exercise and exercise testing. These changes could include heat related illness, abnormal heartbeats, abnormal blood pressure, and in rare instances, a heart attack. If abnormal changes occur, an ambulance will be on standby for immediate medical care.

I have read this form and understand that there are inherent risks associated with any physical activity and recognize it is my responsibility to provide accurate and complete health/medical history information. Furthermore, it is my responsibility to monitor my individual physical performance during any activity. I hereby release the Washington Township Police Department and its member agencies, officials, employees, and agents from any liability for injuries or death which may occur as a result of my participation in the police officer physical agility tests.

I give informed consent for testing data to be obtained to determine my state of physical readiness as it applies to the following list of essential job functions of a Police Officer for the departments represented by the Washington Township Police Department.

Testing Order:

1. 1 Minute Sit-up
2. 300 Meter Run
3. 1 Minute Push-up
4. 1.5 Mile Run

This is a cumulative test. Each event is pass/fail. If one event is failed, the entire test is failed. There is no "averaging" of scores.
