

Wenham Police Department's PHYSICAL AGILITY TEST STANDARDS

The Police Officer Physical Agility Test (PAT), is a demanding component of the testing process. It is strongly suggested that you train to develop your strength and endurance in order to pass this section of the process. The Wenham Police Department has provided some basic training recommendations along with the testing requirements. All candidates are expected to put forth a maximum effort during the PAT. Before starting any type of training program, you should consult with your physician.

Be advised that the PAT consists of a battery consisting of (3) tests based upon the "Cooper Standards." The minimum passing score for each segment is listed below. Failure to pass any stage will result in immediate disqualification from the process. Candidates who will be invited to the PAT will be notified in advance.

** No candidate will be allowed to participate in the PAT if they do not have a signed "Waiver and Release" form with them at the time of their assigned PAT. All candidates invited to attend the PAT MUST bring their completed original application and supporting materials along with one copy of the entire packet to the PAT. Provided a candidate passes the PAT, this documentation will be collected later on this same day and disseminated as necessary for further phases of the recruitment process. The Waiver and Release and Form, along with the application will be made available online and further information will be given at the time of the written examination.

- No candidate will be allowed to participate in the PAT if they do not have a signed "Waiver and Release" form with them at the time of their assigned PAT.
- You must also bring a photo ID. (Driver's license, military ID).
- ➤ No firearms are allowed at the PAT testing site except by members of the Wenham Police Department.
- > Dress for the weather in appropriate exercise gear. You will be running and performing sit-ups and push-ups. Sneakers must be worn.
- All candidates must bring water. You may bring a snack if desired.
- Candidates who are unsure if they are medically fit to participate in the PAT are encouraged to seek a qualified medical opinion from a physician before committing to the recruitment process.

The PAT will be administered by members of the Wenham Police Department, in addition to other assigned personnel of various ranks. The tentative schedule calls for the PAT to begin immediately at 8:15 am. Candidates will be notified of their specific testing time when they are invited to the test. Your assigned time has no bearing on your overall rank and these times will be randomly assigned.

Successful candidates who pass the PAT and are ranked high enough on the eligibility list may be invited to the Interview Panel to be held at a later date. Further instructions relative to further phases of the recruitment will be given on the day of the PAT and at other times during the recruitment phases.
