
Profile:

The Quartermaster is responsible for materials management for the Police Department, inventory control, purchasing/procurement, fleet maintenance scheduling and repair requisition. The Quartermaster will dispose of abandon vehicles according to established procedures. This position is responsible to maintain all fire alarms, extinguishers, and electrical emergency power packs; ensures all building and grounds repairs are performed in a timely manner. The Quartermaster is responsible for all equipment used by staff to include fire arms, ammunition, fire range equipment, and personal protective equipment. This position is responsible to perform on-site inspections of towing companies within the City for adherence to established guidelines. This position is responsible for the direct supervision of custodian staff.
