MANSFIELD TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Mansfield Township Police Department (Burlington County) is accepting applications for the position of Police Officer. Current salary range is \$47,979 to \$100,662 (plus holiday pay) and fringe benefit package. Applicants with three years full-time police experience may be offered higher starting salary. Updated Eligibility Criteria for the Mansfield Township Police Officer Position:

- Must not be less than 21 years of age or more than 35 years of age, unless currently enrolled in Police and Firemen's Retirement System;
- Must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of New Jersey;
- Must possess a valid New Jersey driver's license;
- Must have completed a minimum of 60 college credits or possess an Associate's Degree at the time of application, **this requirement will be waived for applicants that possess a basic course for police officer certification with two years of full-time experience.**
- Must have a good reputation and be of sound moral character and must not have been convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude;
- Must be able to meet the standards of agency tattoo policy (**arm tattoos are permitted** provided they are covered by long sleeve uniform shirt. No tattoos on face, neck, or hands).
- **Those that do not possess a Police Training Commission Certification must reside in the following Burlington County communities:**
 - **Mansfield Township**
 - **Chesterfield Township**
 - **Springfield Township**
 - **North Hanover Township**
