The Evesham Township Police Department is recruiting for the position of part-time SLEO I Police Officer. We are seeking energetic, enthusiastic, and hard working individuals for our police department. The Evesham Township Police Department is an internationally accredited agency whose members take pride in their proactive response to crime, disorder and quality of life issues. This approach recognizes our community's high expectations for professional police services and has sustained a positive relationship with the community for many years.

We currently employ 97 sworn police officers, 81 full-time police officers, 4 Special Law Enforcement Police Officers (SLEO II), 9 Special Law Enforcement Police Officers (SLEO III), 3 Special Law Enforcement Police Officers (SLEO I) and 12 civilian employees. The department is organized into two divisions: Operations and Administrative, and five bureaus: Patrol, Investigative, Support Services, Professional Standards and Internal Affairs. We also offer various specialized assignments such as: K-9 Officers, Bike Patrol, Crime Scene Technicians, ATV Patrol, LEAD, Detective, School Resource Officers, Community Policing, Internal Affairs and Support Services. We offer our future officers a modern facility, excellent equipment and a proactive approach to training.

Applicants must possess a high school diploma or its equivalency, be at least 18 years of age, be of good moral character and able to read and write the English language. Applicants must be able to obtain a New Jersey Police Training Commission SLEO I Police Officer certification, by attending a SLEO I Police Training Academy approved by the New Jersey Police Training Commission.
